GIs data in GIview

- Glview may include the so-called <u>registered data and extended data.</u>
- As <u>registered data</u>, Glview already includes all the available information held by DG AGRI (e.g. Gl type, product type and category, status, reference to OJ series) of the GIs from South-East Asia as well.
- Registered data are ensured from the eAmbrosia digital system the EU register of GIs on all GIs applied for registration, published and registered in the EU and from internal databases of DG AGRI on non-EU GIs protected in the EU (39 GIs from Vietnam) and EU GIs protected outside the EU by international agreements.








Pêra Rocha do Oeste

Product description

Pera Rocha do Oeste PDO is the fruit of the pear tree of the 'Rocha' variety obtained in the west region.

The Rocha variety belongs to the family Rosaceae, sub-family of pome fruits, genus *Pyrus* and species *Pyrus* communis L. It is a Portuguese variety, obtained as a chance seedling about 150 years ago in the commune of Sintra, its natural range being in the west region.

Regardless of the shape of the Pera Rocha do Oeste PDO, the fruit always has a distinctive russeted area around the base which becomes less marked and regular on the rest of the skin and then tends to concentrate around the stem cavity.

The flesh of Pera Rocha do Oeste PDO is white in colour, soft to melting, granular, sweet, non-acid, very juicy and moderately yet distinctively aromatic.

Definition of the geographical area

Municipalities of Sintra, Mafra, A.Vinhos, S.Monte Agraço, Alenquer, V.Franca Xira, Azambuja, T. Vedras, Cartaxo, Lourinhã, Bombarral, Cadaval, Santarém, R.Maior, Peniche, Óbidos, C. Rainha, T.Novas, Alcanena, Alcobaça, Nazaré, P.Mós, Batalha, Tomar, F.Zêzere, V.N.Ourém, Leiria, M.Grande and Pombal.

Causal link between the product and its origin

The region known as Oeste (because it is the most westerly region in Portugal) enjoys very specific soil and climatic conditions, resulting from the soils (dating back to the Jurassic and neo-Jurassic period) and proximity to the sea. The region lies between the Serra dos Candeeiros and the Atlantic Ocean. The combination of these factors gives distinctive and specific climatic characteristics. It is not surprising, therefore, that these conditions led to the spontaneous appearance, over 150 years ago, of the Rocha variety. This variety, in its home of origin, provides the existence of fruits with well-differentiated organoleptic characteristics that are recognised by consumers. Pera Rocha do Oeste PDO quickly became an emblematic product of this region
