## 1.EU in the Geneva Act



## The Geneva Act: born with the EU

- February 26, 2020
- The Geneva Act enters into force with the EU accession







## The Geneva Act: the participation of the EU

- The accession of EU shows one of the main difference with the Lisbon Agreement: International organizations may participate
- 7 Member States are parties of the Lisbon Agreement and have registered Appellations of Origin (AOs)







#### The Geneva Act: the EU in the core business

- Facilitates the international protection of geographical indications by centralizing their registration: one procedure for multilateral protection
- EU bringing 27 states further multiplies the multilateral effect

#### The Geneva Act: the role of the EU





- EU one of the main actor in GI international policy: its accession contributes to global GI policy development
- EU offers protection in a market of 440 millions consumers
- Positive impact on growth and employment from improved GI Protection
- Global protection of local value: the good globalization









# 2. Registering EU GIs





#### EU legal basis

- Regulation (EU) 2019/1753 of the EP and of the Council of 23 October 2019 on the action of the Union Following the accession to the Geneva Act
- Council Decision (EU) 2019/1754
   on the accession of the European
   Union to the Geneva Act









## **EU GI Registration**

#### **Article 2 R.2019/1753**

- Member States request the Commission to register EU GIs (for names not in Lisbon)
- Criteria: the export value, current/potential misuse in 3C
- Commission adopts implementing acts and submits applications for these GIs







## **EU GI Registration**

- Application to World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO)
- WIPO examination
- WIPO Decision on International Registration
- If registered notification to the parties
- Decision on protection







#### Non Agri GIs

- At present, the EU has no legislation on protection of non-agri GIs
- Procedures have been launched in view of adopting new EU legislation on non-agri GIs
- Before the new EU legislation on non-agri Gls is adopted EU will not apply for registration of non-agri Gls and will be obliged to refuse protection for non-agri Gl. Such refusal may be withdrawn in the future









# 3. Protecting 3C GIs in the EU





#### EU procedure

**Articles 4 and 5 R.2019/1753** 

- Notification by WIPO to COM of the 3C registrations
- Publication for opposition in the EU OJ
- Commission assessment (in parallel with the opposition)







#### EU procedure

**Articles 6 and 7 R.2019/1753** 

- Opposition for 4 months after publication
- No opposition + COM assessment OK
  protection
- Admissible opposition or assessment of COM not OK → protection/refusal
- Decision (refusal) to be notified to WIPO within 1 year from notification
- GI view





#### Assessment: mandatory Geneva requirements



**Article 5 R.2019/1753** 

Rule 5.2 of the Common Regulations of the Geneva Act

- Name
- Product category (scope)
- Geographical area
- Proof of protection in the country of origin





#### Assessment: description and link



#### **Article 5 R.2019/1753**

Rule 5.3 of the Common Regulations of the Geneva Act

- Product Description: must be possible to identify the product
- Link: statements deemed correct accepted unless clearly false or inconsistent or other specific reason, material cannot be vague, reputation referred to current context (not past), linked to the name, reporting facts





#### Protecting GI in the EU under the Geneva Act









- Simple: easy procedure
- Favourable: low cost
- Objective: codified procedural rules
- Fair: not divergent results
- Fast: one year for protection
