

QSD-0301 MANAGE ACADEMY ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PROGRAMME (I)







7- Knowledge Management & Repository Intro

ShareDox is the Content Management system or Knowledge Repository which the Office uses to store and share all **administrative documents**. Use of ShareDox is compulsory and all documents should be stored and can be shared by sending links to colleagues.

Background

- No control about information storage
- No common rules and standard about document management
- Use of incorrect version
- Risk of duplicate
- No ISO compliance



LIFECYCLE OF A DOCUMENT





- ☐ The Pan-European Seal Professional Traineeship Programme bridges academia and the IP labour market.
- Partnership between European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) and the European Patent Office (EPO) together with their strategic University partners, as well as Associated Partners such as CPVO.
