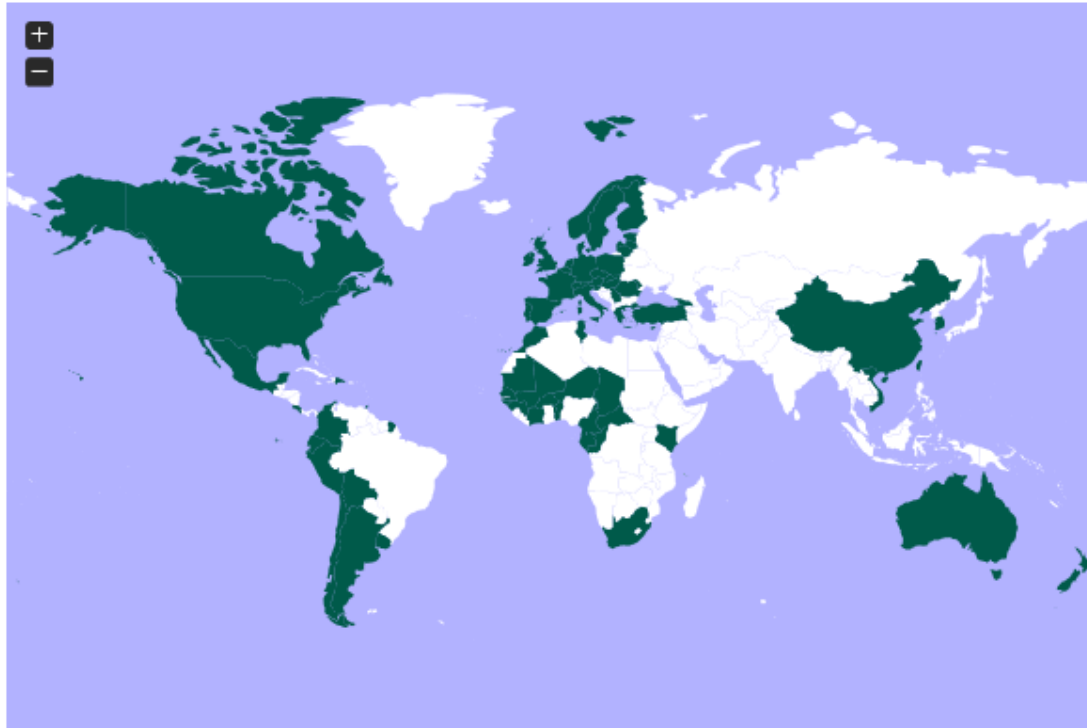

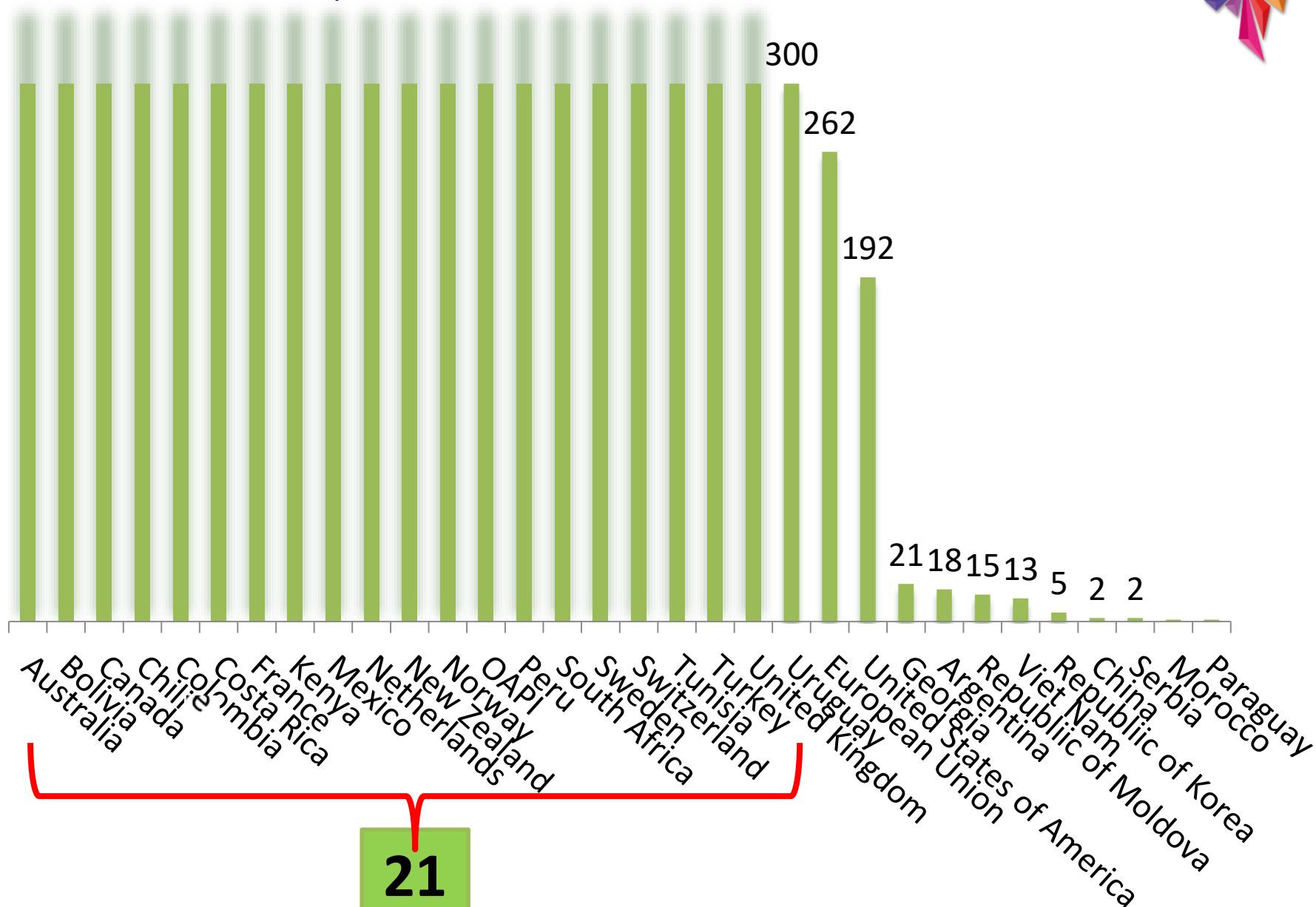

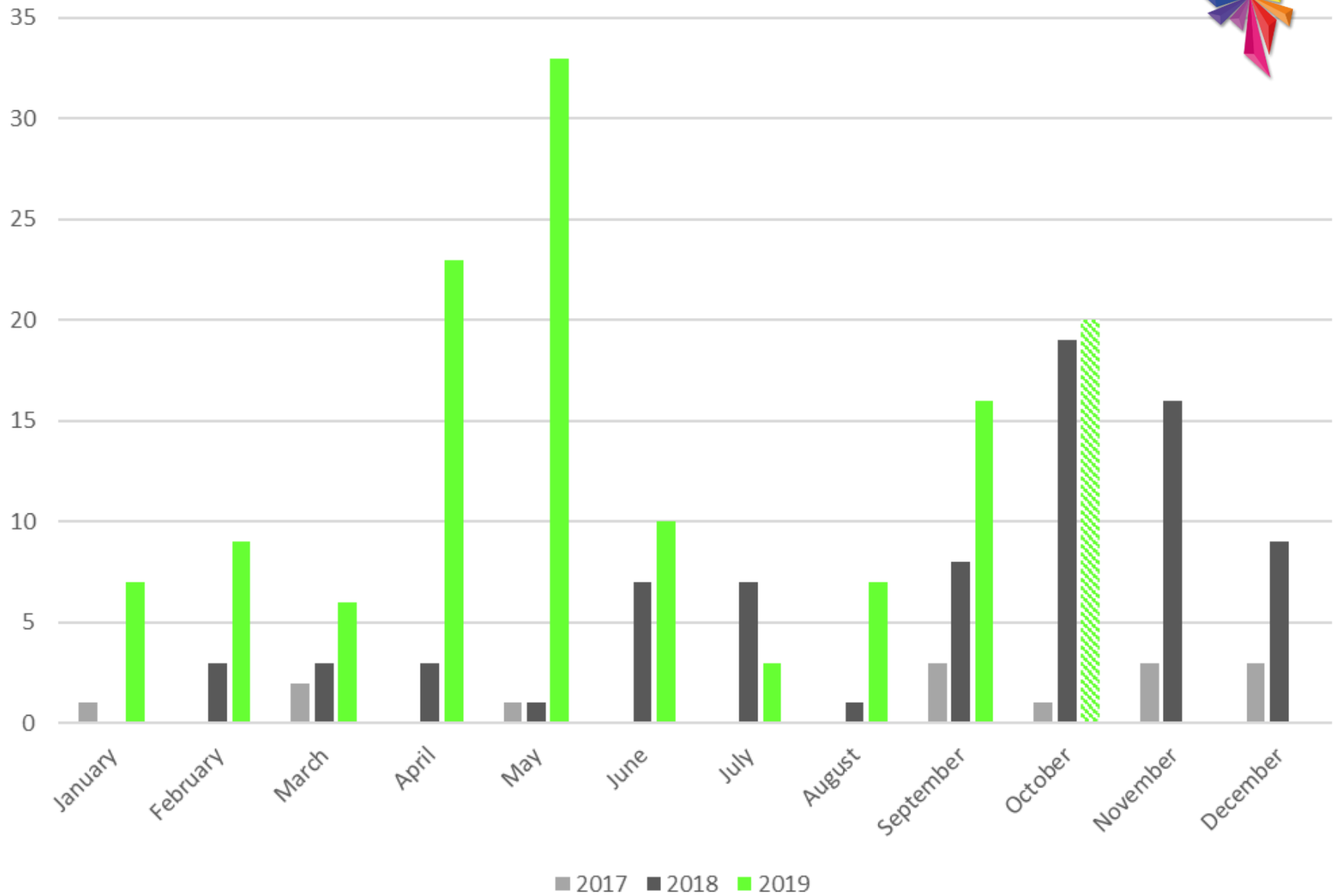

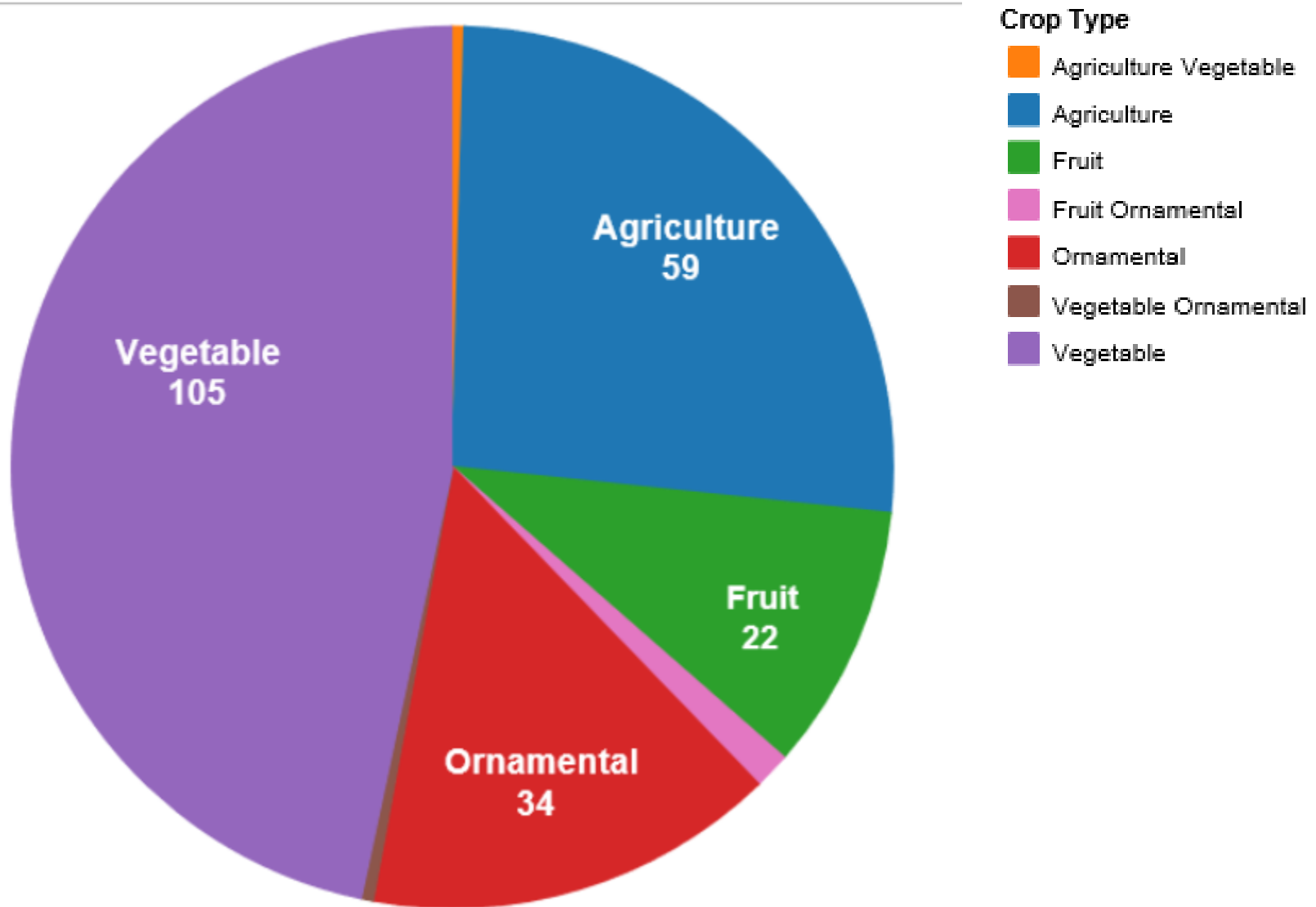

Status on the use of UPOV PRISMA (as of October 25, 2019)

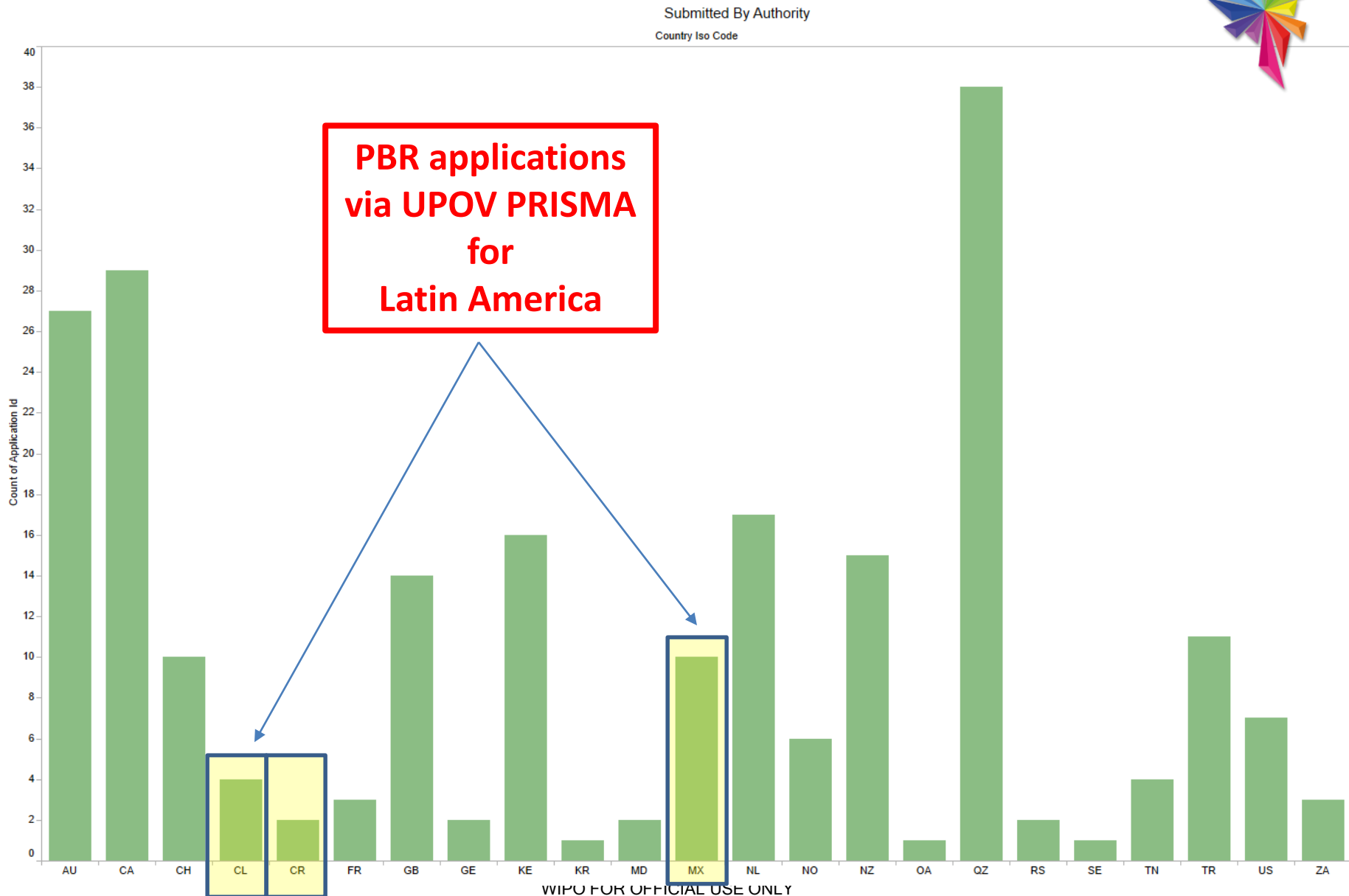
Submitted applications by crop type

Specific requirements in relation to UPOV	<p>Are there any specific requirements in relation to UPOV PRISMA?</p> <p>No requirements have been notified by the PVP Office.</p>	
Application data	<p>Will I receive confirmation that my application data has been received?</p> <p>APPLICATION IS ACCEPTED FOR FILING means that: The required documents and original documentation, and the next steps outlined to fulfill examination requirements.</p> <p>APPLICATION IS NOT ACCEPTED FOR FILING means that: The Canadian PVP Office has rejected the application for filing. An examiner will contact the applicant to provide the reason that the application does not meet the filing requirements, or to provide the reason that the application is incomplete.</p>	
Plant Material	<p>When applicable, where should I send the plant material?</p> <p>In the case of <u>seed propagated</u> varieties, a seed sample must meet the minimum weight requirements. The seed sample must meet the minimum weight requirements.</p> <p>In the case of <u>vegetatively reproduced</u> varieties, the applicant must provide a sample of the plant material that is representative of the variety.</p>	<p>Filing Date</p> <p>What is considered to be the filing date?</p> <p>"filing date" means in respect of an application, the date on which the applicant has provided the required information, fees, documents and plant material to the PVP Office, as reproduced below;</p> <p>" Filing date of application</p> <p>10 (1) Subject to subsection 11(1), the filing date of application, all of the information, fees, documents and plant material submitted to the PVP Office.</p> <p>Notice of filing date</p> <p>10 (2) The Commissioner shall send to the applicant a notice of the filing date of the application.</p> <p>UPOV PRISMA Disclaimer: The authority entrusted with the PVP Office is not responsible for the filing date of applications in accordance with the legal requirements of the UPOV Convention.</p>
Payment	<p>How and when do I pay the PVP application fees?</p> <p>Application fees are sent directly by the applicant to the PVP Office.</p> <p>Will I receive confirmation that the payment has been received?</p> <p>In order for an application to be accepted for filing, the applicant must provide a receipt from the PVP Office that serves as confirmation that the payment has been received.</p>	<p>Dates for submission</p> <p>For testing or plant material purposes, are there any specific requirements?</p> <p>Not applicable to Canada (breeder run testing system).</p>
Agent / Local Representative	<p>Do I need an agent or local representative in Canada?</p> <p>If the applicant is a foreign applicant (residing outside of Canada) and is required for all foreign applicants to have a local representative in Canada.</p>	<p>Additional requirements</p> <p>Are there any additional requirements?</p> <p>The agent or applicant will receive a letter from the PVP Office if additional items/clarification are required, i.e. original documents, etc.</p>

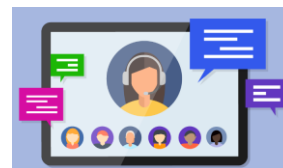
