


IP SUPPORTING PROGRAMS

 Development (3 periods: 2006
 2010; 2010 2015; 2016-2020)
- IP Strategy by 2030

SMEs in Vietnam:

- -Approximately 97% of the total number of businesses operating in Viet Nam
- -77% of the total employment
- -Contributing to 45% of total GDP
- -**720.000** active SMEs (2019)

National Programme of IP assets Development – Main activites

National Programme of IP assets Development – Results (2 period: 10 years)

- Approximately 5,000 programs broadcasted on TV channels on various IP categories with increasingly diversified contents and performances
- Tens of thousands of people trained on IP
- Directly supporting S&T organizations, enterprises on IPRs protection, management and enforcement:
- + Building and implementing the model of management and development IP assets in some groups and associations (ex: National Textile and Garment Group; Leather, Footwear and Handbag Association...)
- + Registration and management of approximately 100 collective trademarks, certification trademarks and geographical indications.
- + Registration of IPRs abroad (currently supporting the registration of 03 GIs in Japan, starting to support the registration of some Vietnamese inventions ...)

Annual activities:

- Training courses and dissemination programs according to the annual working plan: in 2019, nearly 70 training courses and seminars with more than 5000 participants were organised.

- IP Competitions

- IP materials: printed and uploaded on IP Viet Nam's website
- Consulting activities: hotline, fairs, exhibitions ...



IP Strategy by 2030

- Issued in August 2019
- The Strategy identifies the objectives, tasks, and solutions to develop IP system in Vietnam: IP training should be paid attention for building an IP culture in the society
- Strategy implementation the first year:
- + Propagating and disseminating the strategy's contents and implementation plans
- + Supporting localities to develop implementation plans in accordance with their situation
- + IP training, public awareness and consultation activities

Challenges

- The development of technologies and IP systems
- The demand for IP training and consultation is increasing in quantity and diversifying in categories, but...
 - + Lack of resources: experts & trainers, materials, facilities...
 - + Lack of IP awareness of the society
 - ✓ SMEs are very small, low technology level
 - ✓ SMEs do not consider IP as a priority
