Introduction of Copyright Office of Vietnam

Function and duties

- ✓ Making legislation and policies on copyright and related rights and the development of cultural industries;
- ✓ Implementation of measures to protect the rights and legitimate interests of stakeholders;
- ✓ Managing the operations of Collective management organizations
- ✓ Granting the Certificate of Copyright and Related Rights Registration

Legal system of Copyright and Related Rights

- Intellectual Property Law
 - ✓ Enacted 2005
 - ✓ Revised: 2009, 2019, 2022
- Decrees 17/2023/NĐ-CP detailing a number of articles and measures to implement Intellectual Property Law on copyright and related rights (April 26, 2023)
- Circular 08/2023/TT-BVHTTDL stipulating forms of registration of copyright and related rights (June 2, 2023)
 - ✓ Decree 131/2013/ND-CP (sanctioning of administrative violations of copyright and related rights)
- The Criminal Code 2015, amended in 2017: Article 225 on copyright and related rights



Copyright and Related rights Future

> The Legal system:

- ✓ New Decree on administrative sanction of Copyright and Related Rights (replace the current Decree No. 131/2013/NĐ-CP)
- \checkmark Research and Prepare to develop Copyright law like most countries

> Raising public awareness

- ✓ To apply e-government; to coordinate with specialization agencies...

> The Enforcement system:

2. ISP LIABILITY FOR COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT IN VIETNAM

ISP Liability for Copyright Infringement in Vietnam

Article 198b of Amended IP Law & Decree No.17 (April 26, 2023) provide that an Intermediary Service Provider is exempt from liability for copyright infringement by users of its service if ISP takes certain steps when informed of alleged infringement

– If ISP complies with provisions, *exempt from liability* for copyright infringement by users

- If ISP does not comply with provisions, it can be *jointly liable* for copyright infringement by users



Notice & Takedown Procedure

• Copyright owner must provide notice of alleged infringement

– Notice should include evidence of copyright owner's standing, acts of infringement, location, and link to alleged infringing content

• ISP must have a method to allow submission of notice (e.g., email, online form, etc.)



Notice & Takedown

• Upon receiving notice, ISP must remove or prevent access to allegedly infringing content within 72 hours (3 days)

– Must also notify user who posted content

• User has 10 working days to submit notice of objection (counternotice) with evidence supporting its objection

- If objection received within 10 days, ISP must restore removed or blocked content within 72 hours and send objection and supporting evidence to copyright owner

- If objection not received within 10 days, ISP must permanently remove or prevent access to allegedly infringing content



Notice & Takedown

• After objection sent to copyright owner, if neither party files a civil lawsuit or requests enforcement agency to handle the alleged infringement (or court or enforcement agency does not accept application), ISP must restore removed or blocked content

• If court or enforcement agency accepts petition, ISP must follow decision of court or enforcement agency



Streaming Infringement

• For real-time streaming of copyrighted content, copyright owner can send notice and evidence of alleged infringement to ISP at least 24 hours before live streaming

– ISP must immediately remove or prevent access to allegedly infringing content, notify copyright owner and provider of streaming content, and continue to follow "72-Hour & 10-Working Day Process



Notice by Enforcement Agency

• If enforcement agency requests removal of infringing content, ISP must remove or prevent access within 24 hours

- ISP must also notify party whose digital content has been removed and report results to enforcement agency within 24 hours

– Party notified may file complaint with enforcement agency or initiate a lawsuit challenging enforcement agency's decision

• Enforcement agency's request to remove infringing content is evidence that ISP has knowledge of infringement and prevents ISP from asserting exemption from liability
