





Organization Chart of Design Office






Statistics of Patent Application and Grant (2)







Section 3

"design" means any form or composition of lines or colors which gives a special appearance to a product and can serve as a pattern for a product of industry or handicraft;

Section 56

A patent may be granted under this Act for a new design for industry, including handicrafts.

Section 58

The following are unpatentable

- (1) designs that are contrary to public order or morality;
- (2) designs prescribed by

a Royal Decree.



REGISTRATION REQUIRMENT

Section 57

The following designs are not new:-

- a design which was widely known
 or used by others in this country before the filing of the
 application for a patent;
- (2) a design which was disclosed or described in a document or a printed publication in this or a foreign country before the filing of the application for a patent;
- (3) a design which was published under Section 65 and Section 28 before the filing of the application for a patent;
- (4) any design so nearly resembling any of the designs prescribed in(1), (2) or (3) as to be an imitation.



THE LENGTH OF THE PROTECTION PERIOD

Section 62(1)

A design patent shall have a term of ten years from the date of filing of the application in the country.

Section 62 bis(2)

Any act in violation of Section 63 committed before a grant of a patent shall not be deemed to be an infringement of the patentee's rights unless the act is in respect of the design under the pending application already published under Section 65 and Section 28, the person so acting knowing of the filing of the patent application or having been informed in writing that a patent application has been filed for the design, in which case the applicant shall be entitled to damages from the infringer. A compliant for such damages shall be filed with the court after the patent is granted.

Patent ACT

Patent are protected under the Thai Patent Act B.E. 2522 (A.D. 1979), Thai Patent Act (No. 2) B.E. 2535 (A.D. 1992), and Thai Patent Act (No.3) B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), covering both invention and product design. The Acts provide protection for patent, design patent, and petty patent.

2021, We are in the process of amending Design Patent Law to streamline our registration procedures



Overview of Patent Registration



Related Law:

The Patent Act B.E. 2522 (1979) as one of the patent categories (Patent, Petty patent, Design patent)

Definition of Patent:

"the protection for a design's <u>form</u> or composition of <u>lines</u> or <u>colors</u> of the product as appears to the eye, and is of importance to the design. Designs which can be granted registered must be products of special characteristics and can serve as a pattern for a product of industry or handicraft"

Registration System

First to File

Protection Requirement



- Novelty
- Applicable for industry or handicraft

The following designs are not considered to be new:



Widely known or used within TH



Disclosed in a document or publication within/outside TH



Designs which have already disclosed significant content in advertisements (Announced by DIP)



Nearly resembling any of the designs mentioned above



Locarno Classification

Information of Application for Formality Examination



- Application Form (each application for a patent can only request for 1 design)
- Image of the design (hand-drawn or photographed)
 - B/W (color: if the design in is composition of colors, the Reproduction shall be in color)
 - Clear and Concise
 - Not Accept Partial Designs (No Dot or Broken Line)
- Claims to Design
- Description of Design (for Specialized Design)
- Other documents: such as Statement of the applicant, Assignment, Proxy (Patent Agent), etc.



The Central Intellectual Property and International Trade Court



Summary of the Charter Act (No. . .) In terms of product design patents and access to the Hague Agreement










- 1. Improve processes Process for examining product design patent applications to be efficient, fast, and consistent with international standards.
- 2. Modify and improve product design patent protection to be up to date, such as providing some product design coverage
- 3. Extend the protection period for product design patents with an initial period of 5 years and can be extended 2 times for 5 years each, for a total of 15 years
- 4. Add Section 3/1, International Product Design Registration under the Hague Agreement. The important points are as follows:
- 4.1 Definitions and general provisions, such as the definition of "international registration application" and the application of the provisions of Chapter 3, Product Design Patents, mutatis mutandis.
- 4.2 Part 1: Submitting an application for international registration through the Hague system, including the applicant's qualifications. and criteria for submitting applications for international product design registration




ELECTRIC RACING AUTOMOTIVE: ERA -ATOM
