OPTION 1 – EUIPO (Direct EU Application)

One application covers all 27 EU countries



Cost-effective and efficient for broad EU coverage

Requires an EU-based representative for Filipinos applicants














OPTION 1 – EUIPO (Direct EU Application)










OPTION 2 – WIPO – Madrid System

File through WIPO using your (Philippines) trademark as the base

Choose to protect in a) the EU or b) specific countries

Good for multi-country/global protection















OPTION 3 – National trade mark filings

File separately in each country (e.g. Germany, France, Spain)

Targeted protection

Each registration is independent

Local language, procedures, and costs apply









Directly to EUIPO

- > Broad Protection: If you need protection in several EU countries or want EU coverage as a whole.
- ➤ Cost-Effective (multi-country): It is the simplest for broad protection and often the cheapest (beyond 2–3 countries).
- Enforcement: An EU trademark gives rights in all member states; you can stop infringers across the EU with one action
- Cost: Approx. €850 official fee for one class (electronic filing). This includes the entire EU. (Add €50 for 2nd class, €150 per class 2).
- Procedure: Must appoint an EU/EEA representative since the company is in Philippines.
 - File online in **English** (or any EU language, with a second language). EUIPO examines and publishes the application.

International Registration via WIPO (Madrid System)

Cost-Effective for Global: if you plan to protect your mark in multiple regions. For example: EU + other countries (USA, UK, China etc.).

One Application, Many Targets: Centralised filing – one application, one language, one payment covers multiple countries.

Flexible Coverage: Choose: EU as a whole or only specific countries, depending on needs. Can later add more countries by subsequent designations as business expands.

Independent Outcomes: Each office (EUIPO or national) decides protection in their jurisdiction. A refusal in one country does not cancel the others.



International Registration via WIPO (Madrid System)

Dependency: IR depend on your **Philippines basic mark** for **5 years**. If the national mark fails or is cancelled in that period, your international registration (and all designations) can be cancelled.

Costs: EUIPO fee (as from 850€) + WIPO fees (between 700€ and 970€)





Directly to National offices

Targeted Protection: You pay only for countries you need. If you only care about, say, Germany and France, you don't spend on a full EU coverage.

Fast in Some Cases: Some national offices are very quick if no opposition (for example, Germany can register in a few months).



Practical steps before applying

Trademark Search: Whichever route, perform a *clearance search in relevant databases* (EUIPO's *eSearch* and *national databases*) to ensure no conflicting mark that could block you.

Prepare a Clear Mark and Goods/Services List: Define your mark (name or logo) and the goods/services it will cover. Use proper class terms (EUIPO and WIPO have tools like TMclass).

File Application:

For **EUIPO** – use their **online portal**; pay fee in **EUR**; appoint **representative** (your EU attorney).

For **Madrid** – file through **eMadrid platform**, who forwards to WIPO; pay fees in **CHF**; they will handle onward transmission to EUIPO and others.

For **National** – engage **local IP agents**; prepare documents in each language; file in each office (some have online filing in English possible, e.g. Spain accepts applications in English, but correspondence then in Spanish).







Practical steps before applying

Follow-up: Monitor the status. EUIPO will publish your application in about 1 month for opposition (3-month window). WIPO will issue the international reg. certificate and notify when each office is done (up to 18 months). Nationals will have their own timelines. Be ready to respond if any objections or oppositions arise.

Registration & Use: Once registered, use the mark commercially in those markets. Mark your products/website with the ® symbol as appropriate. Diary the renewal dates (10 years from filing for EUIPO and most nationals; Madrid international registration also 10 years).
